COCOA MEAT RUB

Ingredients:

½ cup unsweetened cocoa powder
 2 tbsp ancho chili powder
 ¼ tsp smoked paprika
 ¼ tsp cayenne pepper
 1 tbsp dried mustard
 2 tsp dried ginger
 2 tsp ground cinnamon
 1 tsp ground allspice

Ingredients

White Bread, sliced

Spread 3 tbsp pie filling on a slice of bread, evenly place 1 tbsp chocolate chips over filling, sprinkle almond slivers (optional) and top with a bread slice. Butter both sides and place on a warm griddle. Flipping once ensuring both sides are browned. Cook until heated through and both sides are golden brown.

PISTACHIO BARS

Ingredients

Base Layer:

¾ cup raw cashews
 4 soft dates, pitted
 ¼ cup raw cacao powder
 ¼ cup shredded unsweetened coconut
 1 tsp water
 ¼ tsp salt

Middle Layer:

1 avocado, pitted and peel removed
 ½ cup shelled, unsalted pistachio
 3 soft pitted dates
 2 tbsp coconut milk or desired non-dairy milk
 ¾ tsp pure peppermint extract
 2 mint leaves

Top Layers:

¼ cup crushed pistachios
 2 tbsp shredded unsweetened coconut
 Chocolate Drizzle:
 3 tablespoons dark chocolate, chopped

Directions: Prep the Middle Layer, place the pistachios and 3 pitted dates in a bowl and cover with hot water. Let sit for 15 minutes while you prepare the base layer.

Line a square 9 x 9 pan with parchment paper. Be sure to leave some overhang so it's easy to remove.

In a food processor or blender, mix together all of the base layer ingredients until it begins to clump together and press mixture evenly into the bottom pan, using parchment paper to help you get an even surface. Place in the freezer. Next, drain the pistachio and dates and place in a food processor or blender, stopping to scrape the sides down as needed. Add remaining middle layer ingredients and blend on high until smooth. Spread this mixture base. Add desired top layers and place back in the freezer.

To Make the Chocolate Drizzle:

Melt the dark chocolate over a double boiler, stirring frequently or heat in the microwave on 20-second increments. Use a spoon to drizzle over the bars. Place back in freezer for 1 hour. Cut into squares and store in freezer. Remove from freezer 5 minutes before serving.

BACK IN THYME

Elder (*Sambucus Nigra* L.) Bourtree, European Elder, Black Elder, Pipe Tree: Honeysuckle Family: Capriforiaceae.

Elderberry wine is an old European tradition, but the elderberry, or elder, supplies much more than beverages: From the manufacture of musical pipes to the treatment of human ailments, The shrub has aided countless generations. Man apparently recognized it as a useful plant even in prehistoric times evidence of its cultivation is found at Stone Age Village sites in Switzerland and Italy. He also imbued it with myth and magic. Spirits were said to live in the shrub, and some people refused to cut it down or burn it.

Medicinally, elderberry has been used for common ailments, A syrup from the berries juice was once a remedy for coughs and cold sufferers comforted themselves with hot toddies of mulled elderberry wine. A tea made from the flowers was taken as a mild laxative or diuretic and to promote sweating. Elder flower water, a mild astringent used as a skin lotion, is still sold in some old fashioned pharmacies.

The wood once served to shoemaker pegs, butchers skewer, and needles for weaving nets, as musical instruments. The bark and roots produce a black dye, the leaves a green dye, and the berries a purple coloring.

Elder is considered being nearly a complete pharmacy by itself. The leaves used externally are vulnerably and emollient. When used internally, they are purgative, expectorant, diuretic and diaphoretic. The flower, prepared as a cold infusion are diuretic, alterative and cooling; as a warm infusion they are diaphoretic and gently stimulating. The berries are diaphoretic, diuretic, aperient, and when fresh they make good juice and jam. Elder is a reliable home remedy for cold, flu, fever, skin eruptions, sprains, bruises, wounds, hay fever, sinusitis, tension, constipation, rheumatic discomfort, an immune system booster.

Elders constituents are: Flavonoids (flavonols: rutin, isoquercitrin) mucilaginous polysaccharides, Tannins, phenolic acids, volatile oil, triterpenes, minerals (rich in potassium). The fruits contain flavonoids, organic acids (citric and malic acids), sugars, vitamins (C, B-Complex), cyanogenic glycosides lectins.

Used as a tea for inflammatory conditions of the upper respiratory tract, minor constipation, and inflammations of the genitourinary tract. They exert immunomodulant and antiviral effects.

CAUTION: Raw berries and fresh berry products if not well processed cause gastrointestinal irritations (nausea and vomiting). Otherwise no side effects noted when used properly.

Definitions of some medical terms used:

- Diaphoretic - increasing or inducing perspiration.
- Diuretic - increasing urine excretion and flow
- Expectorant - facilitating the expulsion of secretions from the respiratory tract.
- Emollient - covering, softening the skin and soothing it when inflamed or damaged superficially.
- Purgative - (cathartic)- causing the evacuation of bowels. Stronger than laxatives.
- Vulnerary - wound - healing

Stems of Elder should be avoided due to Cyanide content.




