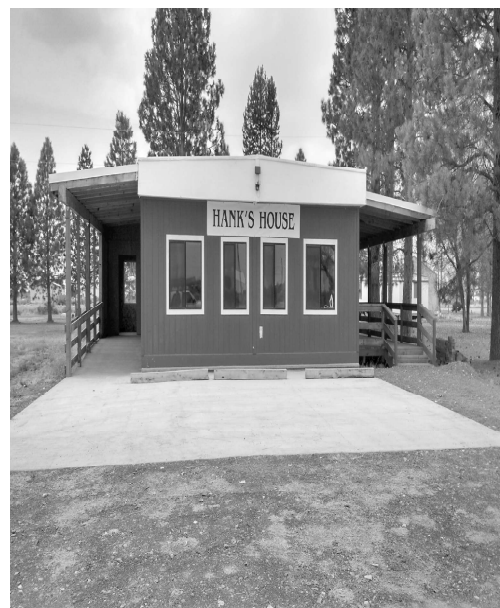

## Free Forestry Workshop Planned

CHILOQUIN, Ore.—The Klamath-Lake Forest Health Partnership will be hosting a free forestry workshop to help landowners understand how to manage their forests for health, wildfire resiliency and profit. The workshop is planned for Saturday, April 20, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. It will be held at Chiloquin Fire and Rescue Station #3, 9201 Sprague River Road, about 8.3 miles east of Chiloquin. Workshop topics will include what trees need to be healthy, the relationship between stress and vulnerability to insects and disease, ways to manage a forest, and looking at a forest from a wildfire risk perspective. Presenters will include Oregon State University Extension Service and Oregon Department of Forestry foresters. The workshop will include indoor presentations, a free lunch and opportunities to ask questions. An outdoor field exercise will be held that will include looking at a nearby forest and applying the principles covered in the class. Participants should wear appropriate footwear and dress in layers for up to an hour of walking in the forest. ## REMEMBERING OUR ELDERS PART 2

Instead of using diet and natural therapies to promote and maintain well-being, “Modern” medicine focuses on disease detection and intervention. Used not as preventives but as palliatives, prescriptions in Western allopathic geriatric medicine create a cycle of dependency, as more and ever stronger drugs are needed to keep the system intact. Much of what is prescribed for even common health problems can have grave side effects for an elder’s more sensitive system. Elder hood “is the time to discover inner richness for self development and spiritual growth. It is also a time of transition and preparation for dying, which is at least as important as preparation for a career or family. From this time of inner growth come our sages, healers, prophets, and models for generations to follow. “Sage-ing” time is growing awareness of what impact our life will have on future lives - and the future of the planet. We don’t question what we get from life but what we can give back. In 1994 E. P. A. reported medical waste incinerators were the biggest source of dioxin air pollution in the U.S..

Mercury ( a deadly neurotoxin) thermometer are still marketed. Pharmaceutical pollution from birth control pills, antibiotics, estrogen, painkillers, and other drugs fill our landfills and permeates our water supplies, affecting every form of life. Prescriptions and over the counter drugs kill more than 100,000 people every year; they are the fourth leading cause of death in the U.S. today. These numbers indicate a dire need to address the toxic nature of prescription drugs! This is the reasoning behind choosing herbal medicine as your primary health care, it is nature’s ultimate ecological medicine.

### Putting herbs to work for elders:

Modern allopathic medicine offers little for elders in the way of preventive medicine that works to maintain well being and radiance rather than to avert medical crisis through all out “heroic” warfare. Herbs won’t cure all problems of elders but they can be as effective as modern medicine at treating ailments, without the long list of side effects, they can serve as a great system of preventive medicine. For most non life threatening disorders, herbs offer a safe, gentle alternative to harsher actions of synthetic drugs. You must be mindful that elders systems are generally more sensitive then the younger adults. In general:

- Digestion and absorption are slower or not as effective.
- Herb circulate in the system longer, creating different effects than other wise noted.
- Food sensitivities are higher.
- Eliminative organs skin, colon, and kidneys are less effective.

Be careful when suggesting herbs to elders who take prescriptions. Combining the two can have unforeseen effects. When used consciously and wisely, Herbs can be combined with other systems of healing to offer highly effective health care.

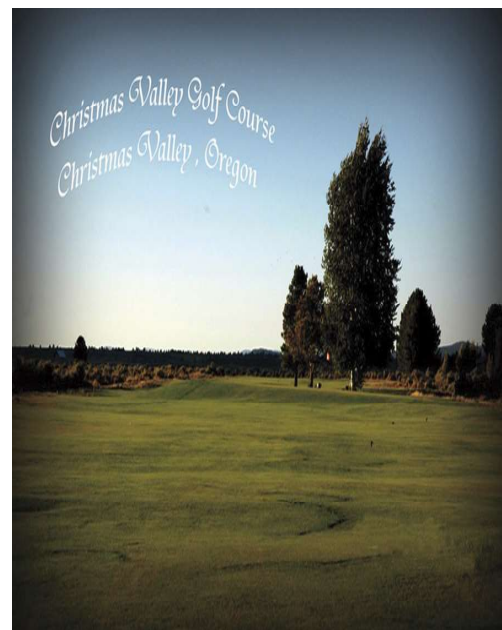
