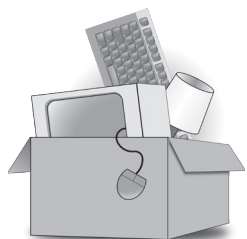

ST. PATRICK'S DAY

St. Patrick's Day is celebrated annually on March 17, the anniversary of his death in the fifth century. The Irish have observed this day as a religious holiday for over 1,000 years. On St. Patrick's Day, which falls during the Christian season of Lent, Irish families would traditionally attend church in the morning and celebrate in the afternoon. Lenten prohibitions against the consumption of meat were waived and people would dance, drink and feast—on the traditional meal of Irish bacon and cabbage.

Saint Patrick, who lived during the fifth century, is the patron saint of Ireland and its national apostle. Born in Roman Britain, he was kidnapped and brought to Ireland as a slave at the age of 16. He later escaped, but returned to Ireland and was cred-



ited with bringing Christianity to its people.

In the centuries following St. Patrick's death (believed to have been on March 17, 461), the mythology surrounding his life became ever more ingrained in the Irish culture: Perhaps the most well-known legend of St. Patrick is that he explained the Holy Trinity (Father, Son and Holy Spirit) using the three leaves of a native Irish clover, the shamrock.

Since around the ninth or 10th century, people in Ireland have been observ-

ing the Roman Catholic feast day of St. Patrick on March 17. The first St. Patrick's Day parade took place not in Ireland but in America. Records show that a St. Patrick's Day parade was held on March 17, 1601 in a Spanish colony in what is now St. Augustine, Florida. The parade, and a St. Patrick's Day celebration a year earlier were organized by the Spanish Colony's Irish vicar Ricardo Artur.

More than a century later, homesick Irish soldiers serving in the English military marched in New York City on March 17, 1772 to honor the Irish patron saint. Enthusiasm for the St. Patrick's Day parades in New York City, Boston and other early American cities only grew from there.

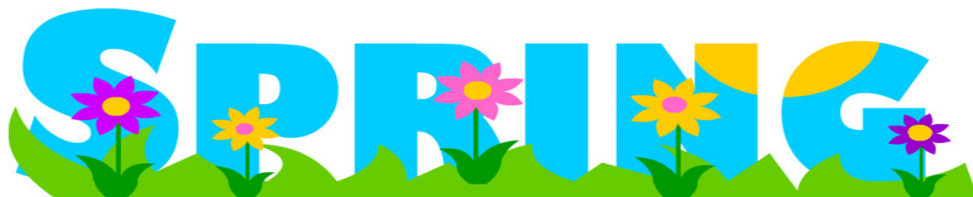

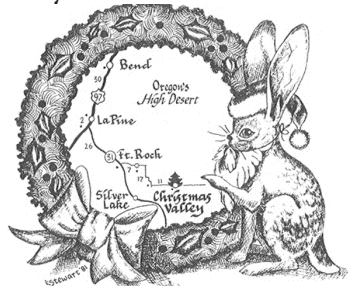

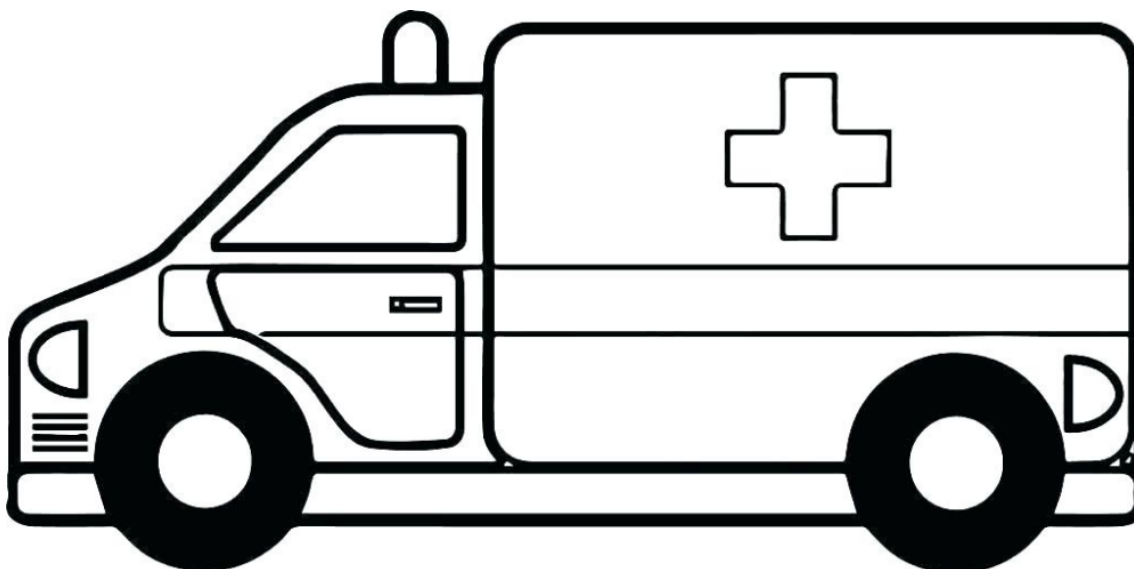

PUBLIC NOTICE

Several of the properties in the Christmas Valley township have utility easements for the **Christmas Valley Water District.**

When you have a utility easement on your property, the utility company/Water District may have a range of legal rights.

A few restrictions you might face include:

- Utility company/Water District access without your approval.
- Utility company/Water District may restrict your use of the easement when your use can harm underground water mains, valves, water meters, and the like.
- Restrictions on physical alterations: You may want to make an improvement to a certain section of your property. But the utility easement may prevent certain upgrades, such as erecting a fence or a gate.
- Vegetation restrictions: The utility company may require regular access to a particular area and constantly tear up your garden. Additionally, many utility easements limit the planting of major trees in a specified area.

If you're considering purchasing a property with a utility easement, take some time to research the local laws and regulations.
