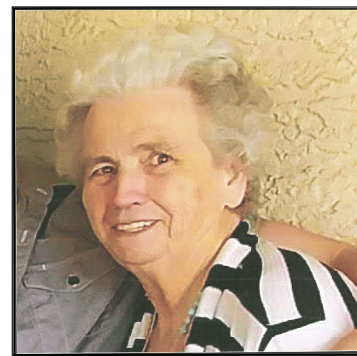
Christmas Valley 4th of July Golf Tournament

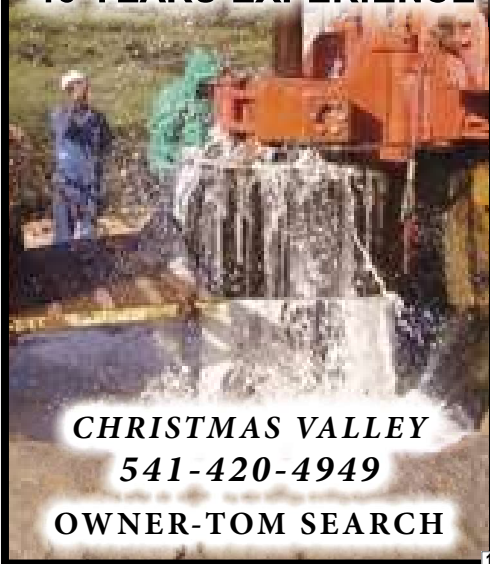

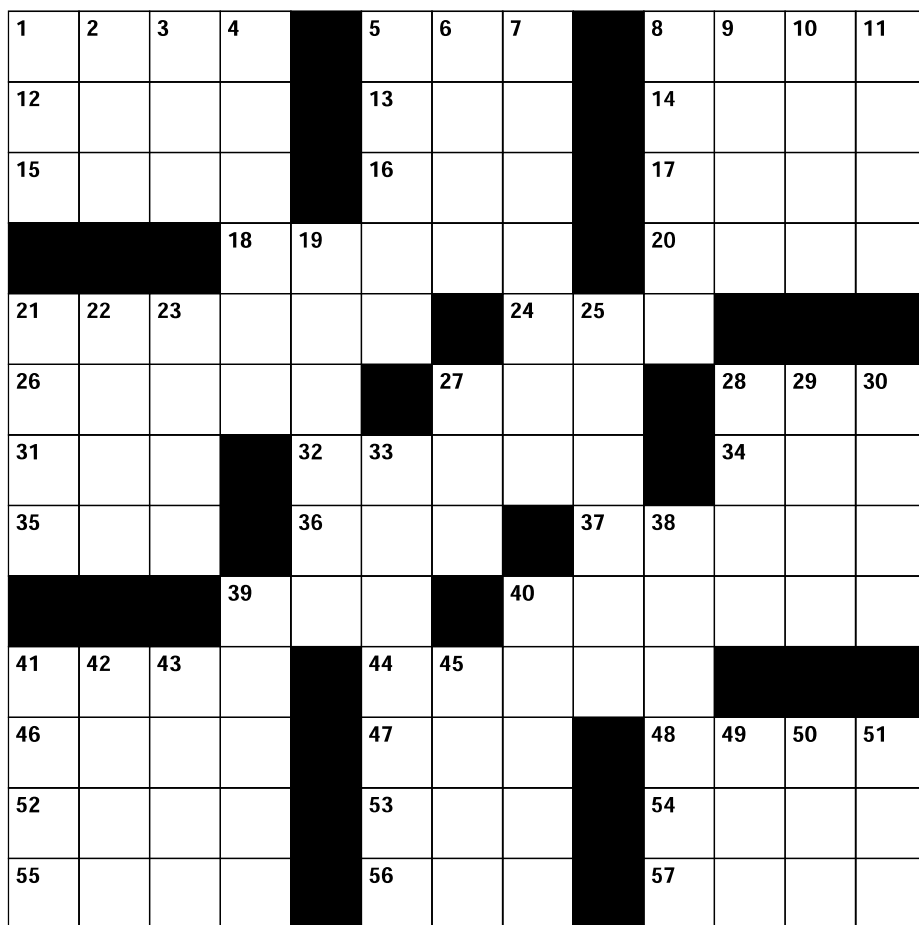
LAKE DISTRICT WELLNESS CENTER DIRECTOR EARNS DOCTORATE IN BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE
