## North Lake FFA unites to ignite at 2019 Central Oregon District leadership camp

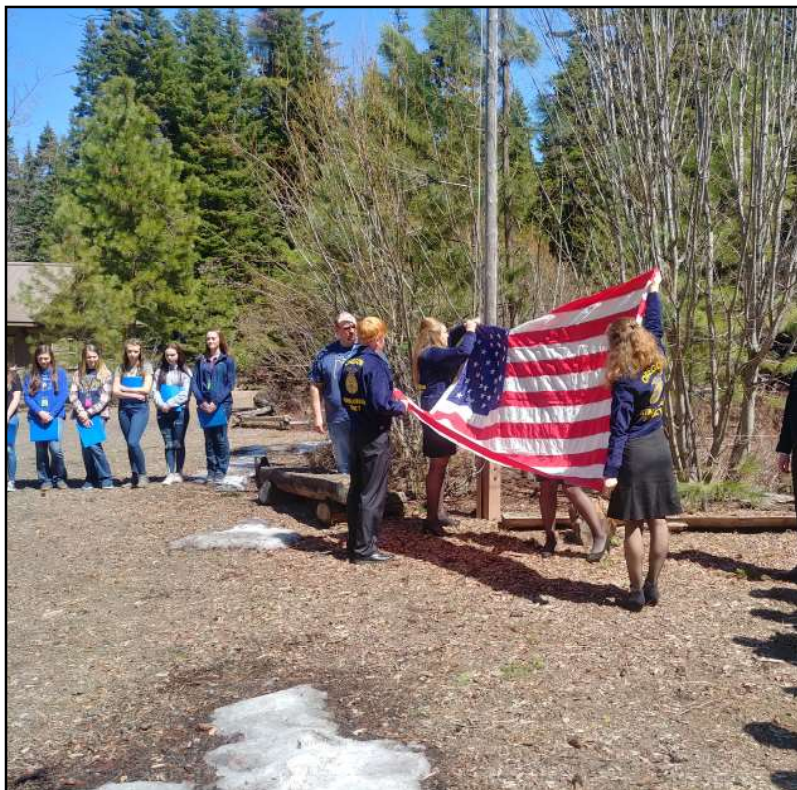

## REMEMBERING OUR ELDERS PART 4

The three faces of well being - are a function of awareness of our bodies strength and weaknesses. When we realize we don't feel vibrant, its hard sometimes to figure out what to do about it. 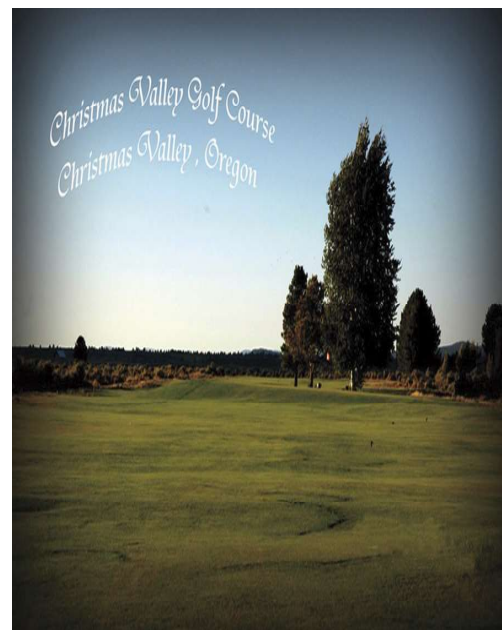
